Prescott Public Library Cell Phone Policy

Prescott Public Library allows the use of cell phones in compliance with the following policy.

- When you enter the library, please turn the ringer on your cell phone to vibrate or off.
- Cell phone conversations that disturb others are not permitted.
- No cell phone calls are permitted in the Silent Study Room or the Ruffner Reading Room.
- Please keep your conversations short and your voice lowered when using your cell phone. If you need to have an extended conversation, please exit the building to do so.
- The Reading Courtyard is part of the building, and subject to the restrictions listed above.
- Please refrain from using your cell phone at the service desks.

Depending on the severity of the violation one or more of the following actions may be taken:

- Warning from library staff.
- Removal from the building.
- Library access or privileges limited or revoked.
- Trespass order from the library for one year.
- City of Prescott Police will be asked to assist with the enforcement of this policy if necessary.

If you wish to report inappropriate cell phone use, contact a library staff member at the nearest service desk.
